

This past week, I was in Cape Girardeau, Missouri evaluating a school's efforts to gain accreditation through ACSI. The school was associated with a local church, and used the educational space of the church for their classrooms. Enrollment for this year has not quite reached 100 students, K-8. For those who may not be aware, HCA began in a similar fashion, using the educational space of Hill-

crest Baptist Church and Second Baptist Church for classrooms. Now, through the grace of God, we occupy a stand-alone facility on ample acreage, with an eye to the future for more classroom space.

Next spring, a team similar to the one on which I served last week, will come to HCA to renew our accreditation. Their mission is to verify that we are who we say we are and that we do what we say that we do. One piece of their process, though, is to interview parents of HCA, and ask questions about the governance, policies, communication, and daily operations. As we draw near to that visit, some of you may be asked to participate in those interviews. In preparation for that visit, we will also ask all of you to complete a survey, similar to the ones offered last year. Be looking for that survey during the month of May.

Also, immediately after the tragic events in Nashville, several parents and grandparents contacted the school with regard to safety measures. Officer Goforth and I speak on a regular basis about the safety and security of HCA. He and I have spoken about different ways to reinforce our doors and windows, and I will share that information with the board so that they can decide on the various options.
