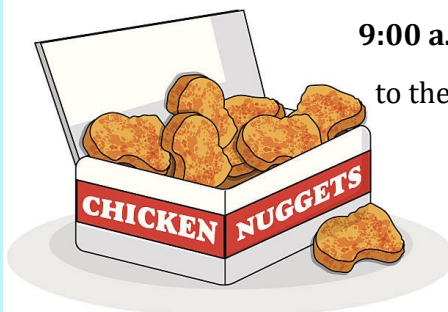

This morning, during our staff devotion time, I shared from Luke 10:1-21. In that passage, Luke summarizes the brief ministry of the people that Jesus sent to "every town where He was about to go." When they returned, they were filled with joy at what the Lord had done through them (v. 17). I then asked the teachers to share ways in which the Lord had worked this year in their lives and the lives of their students. 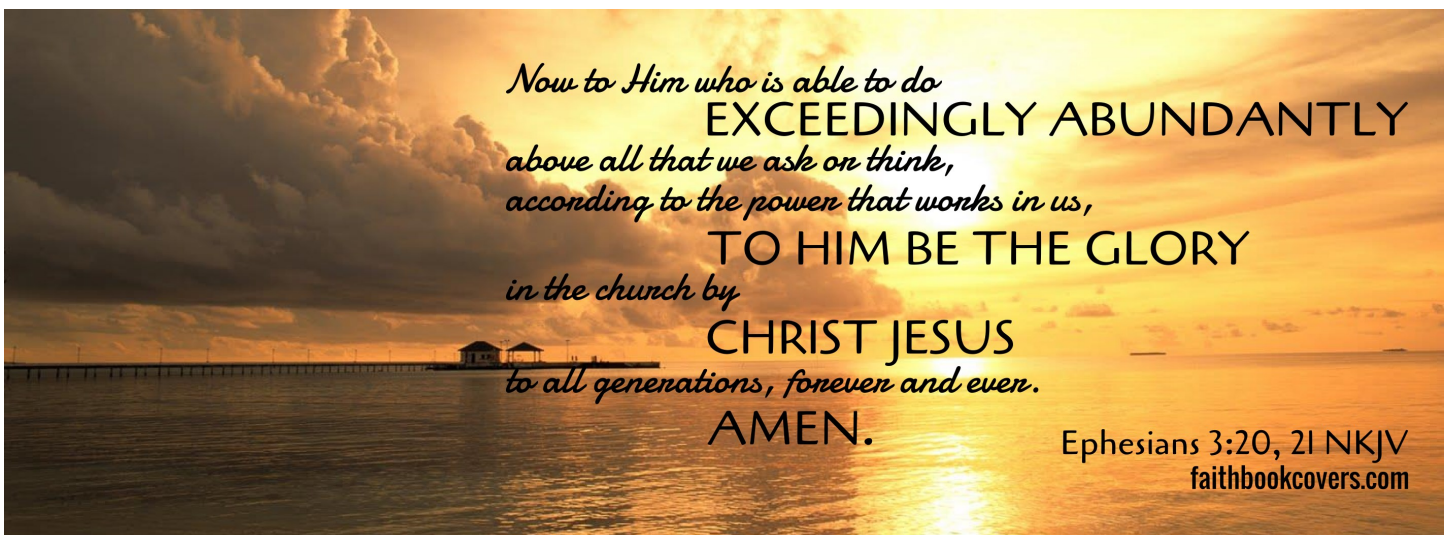

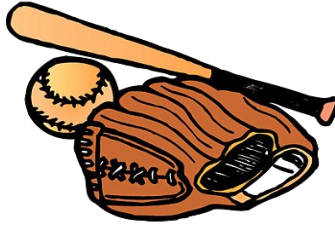

### **CHEERLEADING CLINIC**

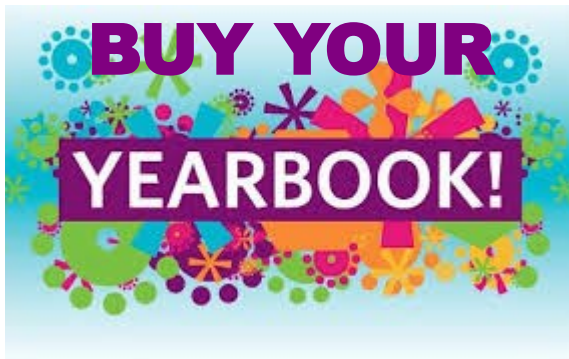
