



Principal's Message

On September 11, 2001, I was serving as pastor of Olivet Baptist Church in Herndon, Kentucky, and was driving back to the parsonage when I heard on the radio that a plane had struck one of the towers of the World Trade Center. As I remember that morning, the image that came to mind as the radio personalities reported the incident, was off a small, single-engine plane that somehow veered off course. The final results could not have been further from that first inclination. Earlier generations experienced similar tragedies that garnered national attention and created simple phrases that etched those events into history. "Remember the Alamo" and "Pearl Harbor" have been joined by "9/11."

During the month of September, Heritage Christian Academy will display the Freedom Flag, a flag to commemorate the events of 9/11, and those who served and sacrificed for the nation on that day and in the years to come. Each element of the flag represents a different aspect of the events of 9/11 so that freedom will remain precious to the citizens of the United States of America.



Also, a piece of steel recovered from the World Trade Center will be on display in the HCA lobby for the remainder of the school year. These items serve as reminders of the price of freedom. By the Grace of God, we live in a country that maintains the opportunity to worship freely, and by the Grace of God, we experience freedom from sin and the grave through the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ our Lord. Indeed, "America, America, God shed His grace on Thee," and that is worth remembering!




