



Though I fail to read as much or as often as I would like, when I want to be challenged with theological thought I will pick up a book by Arthur Pink, Andrew Murray, or Oswald Chambers. Each of these writers presents spiritual truth and provides spiritual insight that often requires extended attention in order to grasp the full extent of his words. In the devotional entry for this morning in *My Utmost for His Highest*, Oswald Chambers expounds upon Matthew 9:38, a passage in which Jesus says, "Pray

the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." Chambers emphasizes that prayer, more than common sense, medicine, education, or effort, lies at the heart of obedience to the Master. He concludes the thought with these words, "Pray....and He will engineer your circumstances to send you out as His laborer."

As much as we strive to provide academic excellence based on Biblical principles (the mission statement of HCA), we strive to provide and expand an environment through which students will learn to hear God's call into the harvest field. At this moment, everything that HCA offers rests on the receipts from tuition and fees. What if that were not the case? What if the cost of tuition for future classes of students could be reduced because of other streams of revenue or financial resources? In the near future anyone who visits the HCA website will have the opportunity to give toward the current and future needs of the school! Those gifts can be directed to any number of opportunities at Heritage – facilities, support for recipients of the fellowship grant, future expansion, quality teacher recruitment and retainment – any way in which the Lord leads or "sends" as His laborers into the harvest field.
