In Acts 13:1-3, Barnabas and Saul are set apart by the Holy Spirit for “the work to which I have called them.” In this passage, Luke continues to use Saul instead of Paul because the ministry primarily remains focused on the Jews at this point in time. This passage, though, does explain the origin of Paul’s missionary journeys. Barnabas and Saul have returned from delivering financial relief to the believers in Jerusalem who are experiencing difficult times, and have resumed devoting themselves to worship and to fasting.

- “The work” to which they have been called results from a certain level of sacrifice. Luke mentions fasting both before and after the Holy Spirit speaks. Fasting calls for an exchange of a preferred activity with a time of prayer. Depriving the body and devoting the time to the Lord requires sacrifice.
- “The work” to which they have been called requires a certain level of separation. They are leaving the men who have been identified as “prophets and teachers,” with whom they have been worshiping. Notice that Barnabas and Saul did not protest that such a responsibility should be given to the “apostles” because they were the leaders of the church, but they accepted this call as pertaining to them specifically.
- “The work” to which they have been called requires a new style/area of service. Prior to this passage, the work of Barnabas and Saul had been among the Jewish people, but now the Holy Spirit is sending them to other parts of the region in which they will encounter people with different beliefs.
- Most importantly, “the work” to which they have been called requires a certain level of spiritual sensitivity. Twice Luke emphasizes that the Holy Spirit is sending them (v. 2, 4). The remainder of the book of Acts includes several instances in which Barnabas and Saul and others have to rely upon the voice of the Holy Spirit to know what to do next.

Each of these aspects reflects the overall mission HCA. Families with students that attend HCA sacrifice for this purpose. They accept separation with regard to homework accountability and personal appearance, and they have opportunities to serve in different ways and through different organizations. Of highest priority, though, is the ministry of the Holy Spirit in and among the staff and students. Pray that his voice may be heard and heeded, and that He will set apart individuals for His purpose which will reveal the Father’s glory.

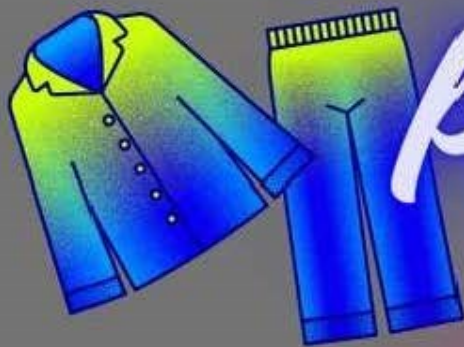
