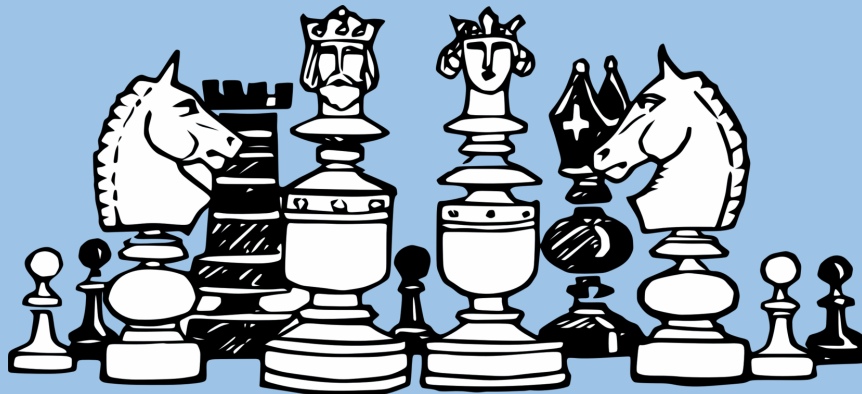


Elementary Academic Team will practice
