

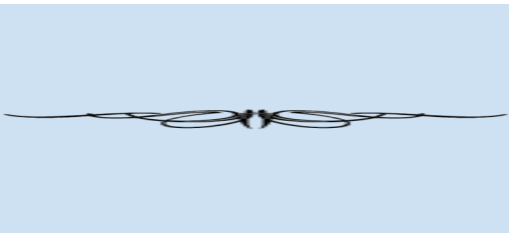

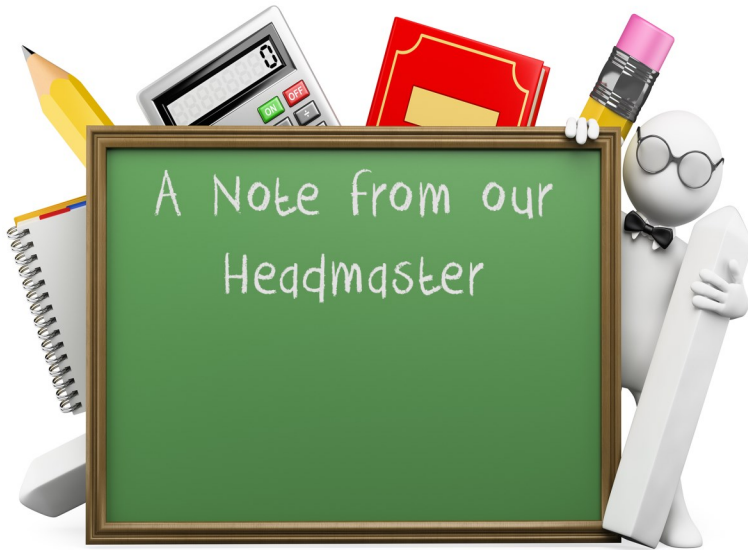

I received an email from a parent last week about the use of Non-traditional instructional days when inclement weather prevents in-person instruction. 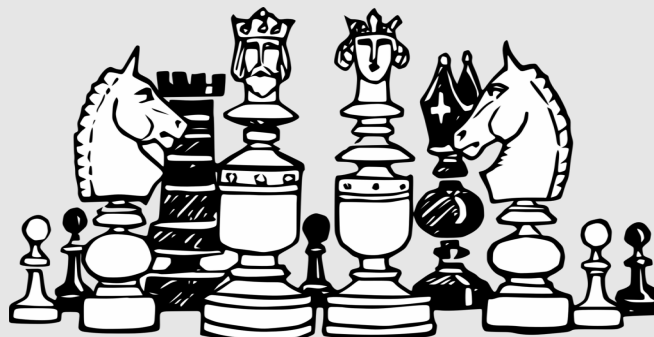
