
"So, we built the wall...for the people had a *mind* to work" (Nehemiah 4:6, NKJV). This year the theme for the staff and students has come from Romans 12:2, with a focus on being transformed through the renewing of the mind. Nehemiah celebrates the accomplishments of Israel as they returned from captivity in Babylon. His story begins with the burden that the Lord lays upon his heart as hears of the condition of Jerusalem. With the blessing of the king and the favor of God, Nehemiah travels to Jerusalem and secretly investigates

the condition of the wall. He shares his findings with the nation and they agree to work. In chapter 4, Nehemiah documents their progress, even in the midst of the opposition that they had faced from the very beginning of the project. Voices of opposition from without and voices of discouragement from within plagued them on a daily basis, yet they persevered, because the "people had a mind to work."

I find many similarities between the narrative of Nehemiah and the history of Heritage Christian Academy, even to the present. As we grow, we find places that need to be repaired, rebuilt, and refined. As Nehemiah never lost hope, we also press on, with "a mind to work". At times we hear voices of opposition from without and at times we hear voices of discouragement within, and yet the encouragement of Nehemiah echoes loudly through our hearts, "And I told them of the hand of my God which had been good upon me (2:18), "Remember the Lord, great and awesome..." (4:14), "Our God will fight for us," (4:20). Later on, he will say to them, "the joy of the Lord is your strength" (8:10).

Our next parent feedback forum will be tomorrow night at 6:00 in the lunchroom. This is an opportunity for you to, like Nehemiah, explore and discuss what comes next for HCA. I will agree with Nehemiah's assessment of his journey to Jerusalem, "I told them of the hand of my God which had been good upon me." And I trust His favor will forever be upon HCA as we follow His will.








