

No School—Winter Break February 19th & 20th



When Paul writes his first letter to the church in Thessalonica, he seeks to encourage believers who are new to the faith. He escapes to Berea from Thessalonica after a group of men recruit others from a marketplace to start a riot in protest of this movement that "turned the world upside down" and which has now come to their city. Knowing the connections that Paul has made with the church in Thessalonica and the context of his departure, Paul desperately needs to know the condition of

their faith as they continue to face persecution. He even voices his fear that the "tempter has tempted you and that our labors might have been in vain" (3:5). In the course of this letter, he reveals that both our heart and our faith are assessed in this life, and he is eager to return to these believers so that he can "supply what is lacking in their faith" (3:10). The richness of Paul's language celebrates the relationship that he shares with these believers, and he expresses a sense of relief when Timothy returns with good news about their convictions. In fact, he says, "For now we really live, since you are standing firm in the Lord" (3:8).

The journey through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) accreditation renewal process enables HCA to celebrate the strengths of the school, see the areas of need in the school, and strategize to achieve the next level of success for the school. This organization provides an outsider's perspective of our efforts, and challenges us to evaluate those efforts against a written standard. A team from ACSI will visit the school during the last week of April. Their focus consists of 6 major content areas which examine the school's instruction, environment, and infrastructure. Currently, our teachers are collaborating in teams to perform a self-evaluation of the criteria used by ACSI. The fact that Paul desires to return to Thessalonica to continue the spiritual development of those believers serves as a reminder we remain a work in progress until the day that the Lord Jesus returns – as a person, as the body of Christ, and as a school.




