JOHN 12:13



In Luke 10:17, the Bible says that the 72 others, whom had been appointed by Jesus to go into the places that He would soon visit, returned to Him with joy. The source of their joy was the power that they discovered in the name of Jesus: “Lord, even the demons submit to us in Your name.” The joy of that occasion often creates conviction even in the hearts of the disciples who read about it.

- This group that had returned are identified as “others.” They were not part of the 12, and there is the temptation to believe that the only responsibility of the crowd was to receive the results of the work of the 12 that He had chosen. This decision shows that anyone can be appointed to go anywhere at any time.
- This group had been sent into places on the future itinerary of Jesus. Just prior to their appointment, Jesus encounters 3 people who were unprepared to follow Him. All three had other priorities – priorities that would demand a defined destination before commitment, priorities that would delay the process of discipleship. It was into this environment that he sent this group of others, and declared, “the harvest is plentiful.” There is a temptation to believe that rather than a plentiful harvest, our landscape resembles a dry and barren land.
- This group had been told that there weren’t enough workers to bring in the full harvest. However, rather being asked to recruit their friends, they were asked to request from their Father – “Ask the Lord of the harvest...” Even those who feel uncomfortable praying may utter pleas for those in need of help or healing, and sometimes even the lost. Here, though, Jesus commands the disciples not to pray for the lost but to pray for more laborers. It is a prayer that will be answered, and it will be answered with us.
- This group had been told not to take anything with them and to be completely dependent upon those whom they would encounter. Moreover, they were entering a hostile environment – “Go! I send you out as lambs among wolves.” A hesitation to speak the name of Jesus occurs when we feel unprepared or afraid of places filled with unbelievers. God will supply where He sends, and He will provide for His purpose. And Jesus offers the encouragement that their use His name among unbelievers secures the place of their name in His book. “Don’t rejoice that the spirits submit to you, rejoice that your names are written in heaven” (v. 20). An expression of faith that results in an abundant experience of joy.

As Easter approaches, this story serves as a reminder that the harvest is plentiful and an aggressive faith is necessary to reap that harvest. This group saw spiritual results from taking the authority given to them by Jesus into a lost world, and proclaiming His name. They proclaimed an anticipated Messiah (“The kingdom of God has come near to you.”). We proclaim a resurrected Messiah who has conquered death and has defeated the devil! Take this opportunity to pray for laborers and to tell the story of a risen Savior.



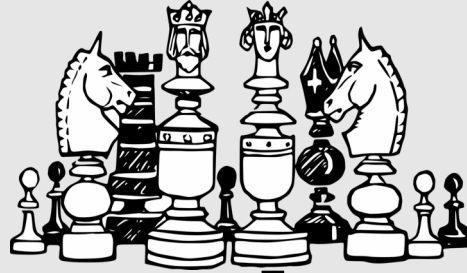

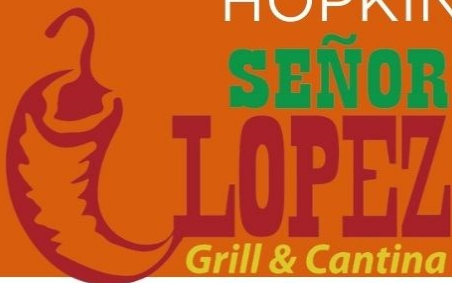
