

The theme verse for this year, "Do not be conformed to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind," focuses on changing the way that we think. These words were written by the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Romans, but the Apostle John also emphasizes the involvement of the mind in discipleship. In First John, the apostle highlights knowledge as one of the criteria of forgiveness. He ends the first chapter by call-

ing his readers to identify themselves as sinners who stand in need of a Savior: "if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1:9). He begins the second chapter with a defined purpose for his words: "I am writing this to you so that you will not sin" (2:1). But knowing the weakness of the flesh, a truth solidified by Jesus to John, James, and Peter in the Garden of Gethsemane, John offers encouragement to his audience by reminding them of the knowledge that brings the assurance of eternal life. As criteria for assurance, John first identifies an "Advocate before the Father, Jesus Christ the Righteous." The nation of Israel also had an advocate who interceded for them before God – Moses. However, Moses remained under the old sacrificial system based upon the blood of goats and bulls. That system served as a tutor for the nation, and as a foreshadowing of the Lamb of God. As John continues his list, he adds another qualifier about Jesus when he identities Him as "the atoning sacrifice for our sins...." The writer of Hebrew expounds upon that identification by tracing the steps of Jesus as he enters the heavenly temple with His own blood, "once for all." Finally, John says, "We know that we know Him if we keep His commands," and "if anyone obeys His word, love for God, is truly made complete in him," (2:3,5). During His last hours with the disciples, as Jesus prays, He says, "This is eternal life, that they know You, the one true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent." When someone previously had asked Jesus about the greatest commandment, He replied, "You shall *love* the Lord your God...." Passages like the one found in 1 John serve as a reminder of the mission of HCA, and its underlying ministry. The mission provides the knowledge of God and His commands, while the ministry encourages the love of God and His commands. In a conversation with a group of 8<sup>th</sup> grade students on Friday, I witnessed the evidence that these two concepts are becoming real to them. Therein lies the passion of Heritage Christian Academy.


